Los Lonely Boys bring 'Texican rock' to Cache Creek

BROOKS, Calif. – Los Lonely Boys, the Grammy Award-winning rock band from San Angelo, Texas, plays their own style of music, which they've dubbed "Texican Rock n' Roll," combining elements of rock and roll, blues, soul, country, and Tejano. Consisting of three brothers who take turns on microphone duties (with Henry on guitar, Jojo on bass guitar, and Ringo on drums) the band follows the tradition of their father, Ringo Garza Sr., who formed a similar band with his own brothers called The Falcones, famous for playing Conjunto music in Southern Texas during the 70s and 80s.

With three studio albums and a live album under their belts, Los Lonely Boys continue to tour, with a stop scheduled at Cache Creek Casino Resort's Club 88 on Aug. 8 at 6 p.m. Fans of the group will most likely remember their debut single, "Heaven", which was a Number One hit on the Billboard adult contemporary chart and also broke the Top 40 on the Billboard Hot 100. Younger fans may remember their hit from the video game "Guitar Hero: World Tour."

In 2005 the song "Heaven" won a Grammy Award for Best Pop Performance by a Duo or Group. Los Lonely Boys' other Grammy nominated songs include "More Than Love" and "Onda," both recorded in 2006. That same year's album release "Sacred" debuted at number two on the Billboard charts.

Mentored by musical legends such as Willie Nelson, Los Lobos, and Carlos Santana (who have also joined them on the road) their most recent album, "Forgiven" is all about "familia" (family) says the three brothers, and portrays a number of themes including what they call "True American spirit," and "Texican spirit."

"When they play they only play what they really believe in," says their producer Steve Jordan, who also produces Grammy winner John Mayer. "They love making music – really love to do it – and are only getting better."
