**Air Supply not yet 'out of love'
*Group still on the road and going strong for over 30 years***

BROOKS, Calif. – Graham Russell and his music partner Russell Hitchcock have been creating music for well over a quarter century as the duo behind the highly recognizable and incredibly successful group Air Supply. Over the years Russell and Graham have taken turns at lead vocals with each voice remaining remarkably distinct, yet together comprising one of the most recognizable blends in pop music.

Any collection of love songs from the last three decades would be incomplete without at least a dozen of Air Supply's soft ballads, many of them including the word "love" in their titles, such as the recognizable hits "All Out of Love," "Lost In Love," "The One That You Love," "Making Love Out Of Nothing At All," and "Sweet Dreams," all of which broke the top five in the U.S. charts, beginning in 1975.

One of those hits, "Lost in Love," became the fastest selling single in the world and leaped to the top of all the charts, with their other popular single "All Out of Love" climbing just as quickly. Seven top five singles later, Air Supply at the time had equaled The Beatles run of consecutive top five singles, with several of their hits achieving multi-million plays on the radio waves and their "Greatest Hits" album soaring past 7 million copies sold.

The group continues to tour all over the world, including a stop at Cache Creek Casino Resort's Club 88 on Saturday, July 3 at 8 p.m. Wherever they go, no matter what the language or culture of their audiences, Air Supply strikes a universal chord. "Singing about love is the main reason for our longevity," says Graham. "Our audiences keep coming back, only now they're bringing their kids."

Over the years, the music industry has changed, along with the landscape of popular pop songs, but the fans have never gone away. "It wasn't always fashionable to sing our kind of music, but we've always stuck to our guns, and I think, maintained our integrity," says Russell.

Their long career has its base in a strong friendship as well. "We know each other better than anyone," says Russell. "We never take each other for granted, never consider not working together, and always appreciate the career we've carved out for ourselves."
