## **Co-Headliners Rick Springfield and The Bangles Hit the Outdoor Stage at Cache Creek on July 16**

**Brooks, Calif.** – Revisit the 1980s with two bands that captured the attention of a generation – Rick Springfield and The Bangles. See them together in the next outdoor *Summer Stage Concert Series* show at Cache Creek Casino Resort on Saturday, July 16.

Rick Springfield, with successful musical roots spanning into the 1960's, became an international star with 1981's *Working Class Dog*. The album included mega-hit "Jesse's Girl" along with "I've Done Everything for You." His follow-up, *Success Hasn't Spoiled Me Yet* and the hit "Don't Talk to Strangers" cemented his place among the decade's most thriving rock/pop artists. At the same time, Springfield's acting career blossomed. He captured a generation of loyal fans with his role as the young and eligible Dr. Noah Drake on *General Hospital*. The two careers complimented each other throughout the 90's and beyond.

The Bangles, often considered among the most successful all-female pop groups in music, scored multiple hits with memorable tunes. With an energetic and melodic pop sound, The Bangles were a breath of fresh air in the late 1980s, delivering delightful covers of "Manic Monday," "If She Knew What She Wants," "Hazy Shade of Winter," and "September Gurls," plus the quirky and utterly infectious "Walk Like an Egyptian." The bottom line is that The Bangles are a whole lot of fun, and their music still sounds fresh a few decades later.
