R&B Favorites The Pointer Sisters and The Whispers Play the Outdoor Amphitheater on July 23

Brooks, Calif. – Get ready for a night of hit after hit! See The Pointer Sisters and The Whispers in the outdoor *Summer Stage Concert Series* at Cache Creek Casino Resort on Saturday, July 23.

The Pointer Sisters musical gifts are reflected in their lengthy list of accomplishments. The sibling group, backed Grace Slick and Boz Scaggs, made stops at Sesame Street and the Grand Ole Opry, won a country Grammy, and appeared in the movie *Car Wash*, all before scoring four consecutive Top Ten Billboard Hot 100 hits in the mid-1980s. From their early 1970s releases on Blue Thumb through their 1980s commercial run on Planet and RCA, the Pointers moved through boogie-woogie, bebop, blues, country, funk, disco, soft rock, electro-pop, hard rock, and several other subgenres as if they were all second nature. The sisters covered Willie Dixon, were covered by Elvis Presley, and released 15 Top 40 Hot 100 singles while sustaining a steady presence on the R&B, club, and adult contemporary charts.

The Whispers are a veteran R&B quintet with an impressive 23-year legacy of hits. Formed in Los Angeles by twins Walter and Wallace Scott, Nicholas Caldwell, Marcus Hutson, and Gordy Harmon (who left in 1973), the Whispers turned up on the Dore label in 1964 with "I Was Born When You Kissed Me." In 1969, the quintet climbed the soul charts for the first time with "The Time Has Come" on Soul Clock, and they cracked the R&B Top Ten the next year with "Seems Like I Gotta Do Wrong." They've remained hitmakers ever since for the labels Janus, Soul Train, and Solar, with smashes like the solid gold chart-topper "And the Beat Goes On" in 1980 and another number one urban contemporary hit, "Rock Steady," in 1987.

The Pointer Sisters and The Whispers play Cache Creek Casino Resort's outdoor "Summer Stage" on Saturday, July 23 at 8 p.m. Tickets are just \$75/\$59/\$49 and are available online at tickets.com or by phone (800) 225-2277; or at cachecreek.com and Cache Creek Casino Resort's guest services desk.
