Chinese Superstar Ekin Cheng, with Kay Tse, Visits Cache Creek's Outdoor Amphitheater on July 30

Brooks, Calif. – In the vast world of Cantopop, few stars shine brighter than Ekin Cheng. See Cheng on his Beautiful Day Concert 2011 tour, with opener Kay Tse, in the outdoor *Summer Stage Concert Series* at Cache Creek Casino Resort on Saturday, July 30.

For nearly two decades, Cheng has been a fixture atop the world of Chinese entertainment. Having starred in many hit movies, many of which were paired with a song sung by him, Cheng has cemented himself into the widespread popular culture of the Far East. Cheng is best known for his starring role in the Young and Dangerous film series. Born in Hong Kong on October 4, 1967, he made his film debut in *Girls Without Tomorrow* (1992). He eventually rose to stardom in the film *Young and Dangerous* (1996), which proved so successful that it spawned an entire series of films. Meanwhile, he also embarked on a recording career as a Cantopop singer in association with BMG Records during the 1990s. One of his most memorable hits is the *Young and Dangerous* theme song, "Age of Friendship."

Kay Tse is a premiere Cantopop songwriter, recording-artist and entertainer. Tse made her debut to the music industry and was signed with Ban Ban Music in 2005 and released her debut album. She has become a prominent figure in Cantopop culture. She is known for her versatile vocal range and expertise in various music genres, especially in jazz.
